John is a frequent organ recitalist, handbell clinician and festival director. He enjoys composing and arranging, having handbell, choral and organ compositions in print with eleven different publishers in the United States, Germany and Taiwan. Dr. Behnke was honored in December of 1993 being named "MVP" Most Valuable Player in the Milwaukee area by the Milwaukee Sentinel music critic, Nancy Raabe. He has also received an ASCAP Composers Award in 1998 and 1999.

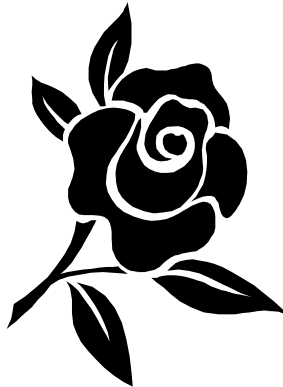
THE PASSING OF A HANDBELL ICON

Barbara served one full term as Area VIII Chair and two unexpired terms. Barb was Local Liaison for the 1995 St. Louis National director conference and the 2002 Area VIII Conference in Collinsville, Illinois.

Barbara was the area chair at my first conference in 1986. I can still remember her many speeches before the start of concerts, etc. Many might remember her famous flotsam and jetsam talk. My first Area VIII Board meeting was in rural Tama, Iowa. Always one to save a penny, Barbara was in charge of securing a hotel. We stayed at a place that I'm sure did not make the "Triple A" guide book and she put 5-6 people in a room. I bonded that night with Ed Rollins and Kevin McBeth. She was also known for bringing snacks, especially Chex Mix to area meetings.

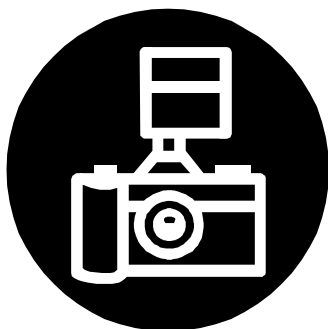
