

No preparation is needed, and there isn't any performance pressure!

You'll get your own copies of the selections (listed below) at the first session.

When you register for this track, you'll indicate your ringing position preferences, and we will do our best to accommodate them. We'll let you know where you'll be ringing prior to the first session so we can get right to the tables and begin ringing s'more!

We'll spend much of the three sessions ringing the level 2 to 3 selections on 5-6 octave sets, and the rest exploring the nuances of stem direction, musicality and mixed meter.

All ensembles are encouraged to apply: chimes or bells, children's groups, youth ensembles, adult choirs, soloists, small ensembles, church choirs, and community groups. All performers must be members of Handbell Musicians of America through their director or through their organization. Performing groups must have 75% of their group registered for a minimum of one day.

One of the many tracks to look forward to is the BronzeFest Ensemble. This track is intended to give advanced ringers an opportunity to prepare an additional seven pieces for performance at the Festival. This ensemble will be under the direction of Larry Sue. Once selected for this ensemble, ringers will need to purchase the seven pieces, four of which will be available at a reduced package rate through Choraegus.

BronzeFest ringers will prepare this music before arriving at the festival and will be scheduled for five class sessions (approximately 6 hours) of rehearsal together. These hours together will culminate in a concert presented to the rest of the festival attendees.

This track has always been a memorable one for those who participated.

The Larry Sue and Susan T. Nelson pieces will be available through Choraegus. The other music can be purchased from your favorite distributor.
